EIGHTH MVC FINAL

- Bradley is making its eighth appearance in the championship game of the State Farm Missouri Valley Conference Men's Soccer Championship and the Braves will face first-year MVC affiliate member SIU Edwardsville in Sunday's title game.
- The Braves are 1-5-1 in their previous seven MVC Tournament finals, but picked up that win in their last championship game appearance, a 1-0 victory at #7 Creighton to win the 2007 tournament.

GRACIOUS HOSTS

- Bradley is serving as the host institution to the State Farm MVC Men's Soccer Championship for a fourth time this week.
- The Braves now have advanced to the championship game in each of those four years -- 1999, 2005, 2006, 2010.
- Bradley lost each of the three previous title games it has hosted, however, losing to nationally-ranked opponents in each game: #9 Missouri State in overtime in 1999 (2-1), #18 Creighton in 2005 (2-0) and in overtime to #18 Creighton in 2006 (2-1).
- Overall, Bradley is 8-3-1 in MVC Tournament home games, including 5-2-1 at Shea Stadium.

BU'S TOURNNEY HISTORY

- Sporting a 14-10-5 record in its 14 Missouri Valley Conference Tournaments, Bradley joins Creighton (29-8-1), former Valley member SMU (9-2-2) and now SIUE (1-0-0) as the only teams with winning records in MVC Tournament history.
- Although Bradley did not qualify for last year's tournament at Drake, the Braves have reached at least the semifinal round in each of their last 12 MVC Tournament appearances (1998-2008).
- Bradley has advanced out of the quarterfinals in eight of nine tries with a 7-1-1 record.
- Bradley's lone tournament title, though, was won in 2007 at Creighton.

NEW BLOOD

- Sunday's championship game will be the ninth MVC Tournament game Bradley has played at Shea Stadium since the facility opened in 2003.
- The game against SIUE, however, will be Bradley's first MVC Tournament game at Shea Stadium against a team other than Drake (4-0-1) or Creighton (1-2-0).

HOW THEY GOT HERE

Wednesday • at (5) Bradley 1, (4) Drake 0

- Moments after moving from midfield to forward, Bradley junior **Christian Meza** accepted a pass from **Aodhan Quinn**, dribbled across the top of the penalty area and drilled a shot inside the right post in the 28th minute for the game's only goal.
- Freshman keeper **Brian Billings** needed to make only one save in each half to record his third shutout of the season.

Friday • (2) SIUE 2, (3) Missouri State 1

- Playing its first-ever game in the State Farm MVC Tournament, SIUE rode a pair of first-half goals to a 2-1 victory versus Missouri State.
- Jordan Barnes opened the scoring in the 19th minute and Jose Tamayo added the game-winner in the 31st minute.

Friday • at (5) Bradley 3, (1) #11 Creighton 2

- Bradley completed the comeback from a 2-0 deficit when junior midfielder **Keith Mach** ripped a quick counter shot off the crossbar and down over the line in the 88th minute for his first career goal.
- Creighton took a 2-0 lead with goals in the 31st and 34th minutes, but Bradley showed it would not fold when freshman midfielder **Aodhan Quinn** scored in the 35th minute.
- Freshman defender **Keegan Balle** equalized the game in the 60th minute.
- Freshman keeper **Brian Billings** made a career-best nine saves, allowing the Braves to rally.

HISTORY ON SIUE'S SIDE

- In the first 19 years of the State Farm MVC Men's Soccer Championship, the title has been won by the No. 1 or No. 2 seed 18 times.
- Although ranked #21 in the country, SMU was the tournament's No. 7 seed when it won the 2003 tournament title in a penalty kick shootout (5-3) versus Bradley after the teams played to a 1-1 draw at Sportport in Maryland Heights, Mo.

SERIES HISTORY

- SIU Edwardsville owns a 5-3-0 lead in the all-time series versus Bradley.
- The first seven games were played annually between 1989 and 1995, but the eighth game was not played until Oct. 9 this year.
- Bradley had won the final three meetings before the series went dormant.

RECAPPING THE 1ST GAME

- SIUE opened its Missouri Valley Conference men's soccer era Oct. 9 by hosting Bradley on its homecoming night, pulling out a 3-2 win in overtime in front of 3,352 fans.
- In a game that saw all five goals scored in alternating fashion, Jack Twellman netted the golden goal in the 99th minute to give the Cougars the win in their Valley debut.

THE SWITCH

- Sitting at 3-5-1 and on a four-game losing streak, Bradley head coach **Jim DeRose** made some shifts in his lineup prior to the Oct. 1 game versus IPFW.
- Most notably, junior **Bryan Gaul** was moved from left back to the top of the Bradley attack and junior midfielder **Bobby Smith** was moved into a central defender role.
- Gaul responded by scoring the game's first goal in the eventual 2-1, overtime win against the Mastadons to start a streak of eight consecutive games with at least one point.
- More importantly, Bradley is 8-3-1 since the switch.
- Gaul has eight goals and four assists in the 12 games since the switch, including four of his five game-winning goals this season.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

- Bradley's roster includes 14 freshmen and 10 of those frosh have played this year, including eight with at least one starting assignment.
- Nine freshmen saw the field in each of the last two regular-season games and the Braves had seven freshmen on the field together during the majority of the middle 30-minute segment in a 1-0 win against Western Illinois in the last regular-season home game Nov. 2.
- Nine Bradley freshmen played in Friday's 3-2 win against Creighton.

TWO FRESHMEN SHINE

- While DeRose has employed a large contingent of freshmen in 2010, two newcomers in particular have stood out: midfielder **Aodhan Quinn** and goalkeeper **Brian Billings**.
- Named one of the nation's top freshmen by *Goal.com* two weeks ago, Quinn has set the school record for assists by a freshman with 10 helpers and his 10 assists are tied for the fifth-best single season total in program history.
- One of three Braves to start at least 20 games this season, Quinn is second on the team with 16 points and he leads the league 10 assists.
- Quinn's 16 points also equal the second-best freshman total in program history, trailing only Gavin Glinton's 30-point season of 1998.
- Billings has started the last 15 games between the pipes and has been stellar down the stretch.
- Billings has at least seven saves in each of the last five regular-season games and totalled 17 saves in the two upsets of Creighton in the last week.

ONE POINT TO 30

- Junior forward **Bryan Gaul** enters Sunday's game in need of just one more point to record just the .
- With 12 goals and five assists, Gaul's 29 points are the most by a Brave since Preston Good led the squad with 32 points in 2003.
- Only five individuals in program history have posted 30-point seasons.
